Once you have created an update disc, follow the procedure below to update the firmware on your device.

- 1. Turn the device on by pressing the **[STANDBY/ON]** button. If there is a disc in the unit, remove it and close the tray.
- 2. Press the **[SETUP]** button on the remote to display the Setup menu.

If this happens, unplug the power cord for about 30 seconds, then plug the power cord back in. Turn on the unit and verify the firmware version (refer to step 14). If the updated version is not shown, please repeat the update procedure.
- 14. To confirm that the update was successful, press **1**, **2**, **3**, **4**, **[Display]** on the remote within three seconds. The following menu will appear. Verify that the **Version** matches the file you downloaded.

15. Press the [POWER] button on the remote to exit out of the menu and power off the unit. PLEASE NOTE: If you press the STOP [I] button on the remote control while in this menu, your device will be reinitialized (all settings will be reset to their factory defaults)!
