Install the firmware update

Once you have created a disc, follow the procedure below to update the firmware on your device. Please keep in mind; after the firmware update is installed the device's settings are going to reset back to default.

- 1. Turn on your Blu-ray Player
- 2. Make sure there is no disc in the tray.
- 3. On the remote press the following in a row: [9], [8], [7], [6] and [POP Menu / Menu] within 3 seconds. The disc tray will open and the following screen will display the Firmware Update screen.

5. The Disc Tray will open, and then remove the disc.

6. Close the tray and the firmware upgrade begins. Watch the display on the unit itself for percentage of completion. **Do not turn off the power of the unit**; **it may cause damage to the unit**. When complete, a HEXIDECIMAL Number, 143A or similar, will be displayed on the front of the unit.
